Quilt Explosion 2007 Rules

All entries will be juried.

Each entry must be entered into one category. Please select from the following.

Appliquéd- Quilts that are predominantly the appliquéd technique.

Pieced- Quilts that are predominantly the pieced technique.

Whole Cloth- A piece of fabric that has not been altered other than the quilting.

Theme- The theme this year is "Nature's Garden"

Group-A quilt **top** that has been worked on by two or more people.

Miniature- A scaled down version of a full-sized quilt. The maximum size is 80" around the outside edge. (ex. 20"x20")

Original Design- The quilt has to be of an original design. It cannot be from a known or published pattern.

Novelty-Any technique that does not come under the definition of "quilted". (ex. Crazy Patch, Cathedral Window, Embroidery etc.)

Wearable-These items should be quilted all or in part and include 3rd layer.

Mixed- A quilt top where no one method predominates. (Ex. 50% pieced and 50% appliquéd)

No items made from kits will be accepted.

All entries should be clean, properly labeled, and ready to hang, with a 4" hanging sleeve at the top. Instructions will be given with confirmation of your entry's acceptance.

All entries must have been completed after June 1, 2002.

No items entered in previous Quilt Explosions will be allowed.

Entrants are to submit the following:

- One completed and signed entry form for each entry.
- Three color photographs (4"x6" or less) for each entry: full front view, full back view, and a close up of the details. Label the photos with your name, the quilt's title, the hanging size, and the quilt's top indicated with an arrow. Photos will not be returned.
- Entry fee of \$6.00 for each item entered. Members of Tri-County Quilters receive their first entry free. Checks are to be made payable to "Tri-County Quilters Guild Inc."
- A stamped and self addressed business envelope for notification of the jury's decision. (Only one per entrant)

INFORMATION

Tri-County Quilters Guild Inc. (TCQG) reserves the right to re-assign any entry or to eliminate a category. If there are less than 4 quilts in a category, we may reassign those quilts. Prizes are given at the Judges discretion.

Entry fees will not be returned.

TCQG reserves the right to reject any entry at show time, if we find the rules were not followed.

Anyone may enter according to the rules.

Security will be provided 24 hours a day during the show.

Please check with your insurance agent to make sure that your quilt is covered under your homeowners' policy while it is on display. Some companies require a temporary rider on the policy and others cover it while away from home for short periods of time.

Sale inquiries about your quilt will be given to you when your quilt is returned to you on Sunday.

Shipping costs are the responsibility of the entrant.

Awards

In addition to ribbons, we will award the following cash prizes:

1 st , 2 nd , and 3 rd in each category	\$30/\$20/\$10
Best of Show, Viewer's Choice, and Best Theme quilt	\$50 each
Best Hand Quilting*, Best Machine Quilting*	To be determined
Judges Choice (2)	\$25 each
Best Use of Color	To be determined

* Quilts eligible for Best Hand Quilting and Best Machine Quilting Awards must be the work of one person.

Additional ribbons may be awarded as merited.
